

# Kansas City Water Works – Quindaro Pumping Station Glass Plate Negative Collection (KSCOLL 2)

The Kansas City Waterworks supplied water to both KCK and KCMO beginning in 1872. Constructed in 1887, the Quindaro pumping station supplied 40,000,000 gallons of water each day to the growing metropolis.

This collection consists of 242, 5" x 7" glass plate negatives of the Kansas City Water Works – Quindaro Pumping Station.

**Custodial history:** The glass negatives in this collection are from the collection of Wilborn & Associates, a commercial photography company. The negatives were part of a larger collection of historic Kansas City photographs, more than 500,000 of which were donated to the Jackson County Historical Society in

Independence, Missouri. The negatives were stored in the caves on 31<sup>st</sup> Street and donated when the business was sold in 2017.

#### **Collection Description**

#### **Historical Note**

Constructed in 1887-1888, the Kansas City Waterworks Quindaro pumping station situated on the Missouri River supplied water to both Kansas City, Kansas and Kansas City Missouri in the late 19<sup>th</sup> and early 20<sup>th</sup> centuries. The water was pumped directly from the river into settling basins where it was treated and pumped into the Turkey Creek Station basins and then on to the service mains. When the Quindaro Station was completed, Kansas City, Kansas had a population of between 30-40,000 residents and had the second largest water works in the country, capable of pumping 40,000,000 gallons of water per day into reservoirs with a capacity of 60,000,000 gallons. 175 miles of water mains ran through the cities on both sides of the state line. The type of machinery depicted (steam engines, horses and carts) suggest that the photos were taken in the early 1900s.

# **Arrangement Note**

The plates are arranged roughly in the original order in which they were received. The negatives were stored stacked in a large cardboard box with paper interleaving between each plate. The glass plates were dusted and placed in archival folders along with a few handwritten notes and sheets of paper with the Kansas City, Kansas Water Works — Quindaro Station printed on them. Each plate has a brief description and an identification number.

#### Scope and content note

This series of photographs of the Kansas City Waterworks, Quindaro Pumping Station was created sometime between the late 19<sup>th</sup> and early 20<sup>th</sup> centuries. The images depict work and construction at the station including the pump house and smokestack, construction or repair of the basins, willow mattresses and rubble being used to prevent riverbank erosion.
